## A new University.....

- The State University of Tetova is a Higher Education Institution, mainly oriented towards sciences, arts and as an independent body, its mission is population's education and emancipation in Republic of Macedonia and wider .
- The State University of Tetova is founded on 17 December 1994 as an initiative of Albanian intellectuals in Republic of Macedonia, Albanian political parties, nongovernmental organizations and others who where dedicated to build an educative basis in and outside the country.
- Important dates:
  - 1994 - University of Tetova founded
  - 2004 - Legalization of State University of Tetova according to the Law of Higher Education of RM
  - 2007 - Accreditation of 10 Faculties and 1 Institute
  - 2008 - Medical Sciences with 4 study programs starts functioning  
New faculty: Faculty of Business Administration
  - 2008 – Signature of Magna Charta (Bologna)

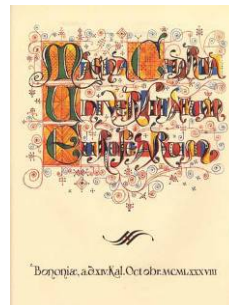
