Content @ International Office

- Mobility organisation (paper work, no partner search, no content)
- Welcome and farewell as well as presentation of University (contacts, e-learning, library, sports...)
- Information about funding opportunities and recent calls (newsletter)
- Supporting application for funding (contact to national service units, EU, etc.)
- Help-Line for project implementation (instruments for calculations or administration e.g. Summer-Schools)

 - Only upon activities from departments
 - Only limited; max. duration until 2013



Internationalisation @ Home

- Very limited number of incoming students
- Very limeted number of incoming staff (ERASMUS)

BUT:

- Only 20% of lectures by staff of our University
- Over 50% not from Austria
- About 10% from outside of EU
